

Suggestions for Single Plant Containers

Plant	Sun	Notes
Begonias		Many varieties; avoid direct afternoon sun; water routinely
Ferns		Need consistent moisture; avoid harsh sunlight
Caladiums		Thrive in warm humid environments; toxic to pets and people
Coleus		Pinch back routinely to encourage bushy leaf growth
Hydrangea		Use large container (18-20"); maintain moisture; am sun/pm shade
Fuchsia		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Japanese Maple		Use large container; choose dwarf variety
Impatiens		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Boxwood		Grows wide shallow root system—choose pot wider than boxwood
Lantana		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Petunias		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Palms		Use well draining coarse soil; dwarf varieties
Angelonia		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely; small containers
Ornamental Peppers		Fun colorful container plant; grown for colors, not food
Roses		Use large container; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Verbena		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Basil		Edible herb; pinch back for bushy growth; water-feed routinely
Calibrachoa		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
Lavender		Likes to dry out; use terra cotta pots; sandy/coarse soil
Rosemary		Likes to dry out; use terra cotta pots; sandy/coarse soil
Geraniums		Variety of colors; water-feed-deadhead routinely
